Important Information:

Newsletter- I will send home a newsletter every Friday starting the second week of school. This will keep you informed on what your child is learning and classroom/school events. A paper copy will come home in your child's take home folder.

Take home folder- Your child will have a classroom folder that they will take to and from school each day. Inside this folder will be classwork, teacher notes and a weekly agenda sheet. This sheet will show our weekly schedule and your child's daily behavior. PLEASE sign this each night under the appropriate day, empty the folder and return to school with your child. There will be a comment section for parents and myself, if a comment is needed for anything.

Snacks- Each child will need to bring a snack this year to school. PLEASE bring an individually wrapped snack. There will be NO sharing of snacks. If a child forgets their snack, I will have extra wrapped snacks.

Birthdays- We love to celebrate Birthdays!! If your child wants to share a treat with the class, please bring individually wrapped snacks for the whole class. NO cupcakes etc.

Bible Verse- A bible verse will come home every Monday. Please practice this all week, and your child will recite it outloud on Friday! We will integrate this verse during the week in the classroom, and discuss how we can use it in our daily lives!

Homework- Starting the third week of school, we will have Spelling homework. We will have separate Spelling Lists for both grades. Encourage your child to practice these words during the week and we will have a Spelling Test on Friday.

Water Bottles- The school is allowing each child to bring a water bottle to school. PLEASE bring a plastic bottle for our classroom. We will fill bottles up throughout the day when needed. Your child will be responsible for taking this bottle home each day and returning with it the next day!
