We cannot thank everyone enough for their help in securing donations, donating to class baskets, bidding on things and joining us for the night! We hope you had a blast. We welcome any and all feedback about the festival, so please feel free to let us know what you thought!

As far as fundraisers go...

Raffle ticket sales hit an all-time record, with total proceeds of \$2,345!

The **silent auction** was extra silent thanks to the addition of the Bid Beacon App! We raised \$5981, \$81 of which we had to give back for credit card sales fees, so a flat \$5,900 profit there!

Then, after paying the Hot Rods for all the great food we ate, deducting for some auction supplies, buying the pottery pieces and street signs, we had an additional \$3,500!

Total profit: \$11,750(ish)- We are still waiting on final cost of pottery pieces.
